How PayPal works?

Payments with PayPal are very simple to perform. All one needs to have is an account and some founds on it. Money can be transferred from and back into the personal bank account, associated with PayPal service. PayPal platform also supports credit and some debit* cards.

When performing an on-line transaction, it is important to take some security measures. (1) Confirm that the displayed content comes from the right source - note the data encryption presence (HTTPS), the host's name and the certificate validity. Modern browsers usually show a yellow address bar for all this and mark the certificate on green. (2**) Make sure you transfer the founds to the right person and (3) for the goods you really intend to. (4) The screen shown below is specific when sending money directly from PayPal account. To complete the transaction, type in your PayPal login, password, click 'Continue' and follow further instructions.

Payment transaction can be aborted at any moment. Transerred founds can also be returned back to the sender, after when the order has been payed for (transaction completed successfully).

* Not all debit cards work with PayPal.
